

BEACH EROSION COMMITTEE MEETING 10-26-00

The purpose of the meeting was to review the status of the four studies that were recommended by the Beach Erosion Committee, approved by the Stakeholders Evaluation Group, and accepted for action by the Georgia Ports Authority and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The following was determined:

- 1. The Beach Erosion/Sand Budget Study is approximately one-half complete. Calibration of the model with the new data is the next phase.**
- 2. The Coarse/Fine Sand Ratio has been approved, comprising mostly of research into existing agency rules and guidelines, plus related scientific reports. Funding of the study is pending submission, review and approval of the study scope and contents from ATM, which they provided recently.**
- 3. A draft Scope of Work combining the two Beneficial Use Of Dredged Materials Benefit/Cost Studies into one comprehensive study has been prepared by William Bailey, and is currently under review at Lockwood Green. Federal funding towards this study is expected to be approved by Congress and the President within the next two months.**
