

Interim SEG Meeting Summary March 7, 2006

During the update on the project's status, there was considerable discussion about the public meeting scheduled for July 2006 and hosted by the Corp to discuss impacts. The group requested GPA ask the following of the Corps: a record of the meeting in some format with a preference of a court reporter and more information as to the format of the meeting. Hopefully an answer to these questions will be available at the next interim meeting.

The group discussed the history section of the final SEG report as tasked by the SEG at its last meeting. The following suggestions were made by the interim committee:

- The report (letter) length should be no longer than two pages.
- The history section of the letter should be factual and straightforward. Support was expressed for the inclusion of pivotal issues debated by and instrumental to the SEG such as the definition of consensus.
- Any references to meeting transcripts and documents should be clearly made in the letter.
- The group recommended three individuals work on the actual text of the letter. Teri Beard, Will Berson and Judy Jennings were nominated and will present text on the history of the SEG to review at the next interim meeting as well as a list of potential attachments for the report.
- An email will be sent to the committee chairs asking if they want to include a summary report as an attachment in the SEG report and whether their group will comment on the scientific studies only or both the studies and the impacts/mitigation.

Tom Wright requested a summary of deliverables (the models and associated monitoring equipment) be included in the Corps final report.

Recommendations to Facilitator for the next SEG meeting agenda:

- Briefing of EFDC & WASP model calibration agency review comments by USACE, Savannah District
- Possible briefing on status of chloride analysis – NOTE: this is a potential item that needs to be confirmed by Alan Garrett or Bill Bailey with the Savannah District.

Next meeting recommendation: Move the next SEG meeting to May 2, 2006. Hold an Interim SEG meeting on April 4, 2006 at Lockwood Greene at 1:00 PM in lieu of a full SEG meeting.
