

Interim SEG Meeting Summary August 15, 2006

Attendees: Bill Bailey, Teri Beard, Will Berson, Gail Bowers, Larry Keegan, Robb Webb, Tom Wright

The following tasks for the project were discussed:

- Hurricane surge report – this is complete
- The scope of work has been posted for the design of the dissolved oxygen system
- Ship wake report (changes in wakes with different size ships) should be ready for September meeting. The next component is to take the results from this study and look at what erosion (if any) would be caused by the waves from the ship wakes.
- USACE met with GA DNR & Eric Olson (representing City of Tybee Island) to discuss near-shore placement of sediments.
- Hydrodynamic & water quality models have been approved by the agencies. Still working on marsh succession model.
- Screening of mitigation options has begun and will continue with the agencies.
- Reminder that two public workshops are currently scheduled: a mid-November workshop to discuss impacts and a mid-March workshop to discuss mitigation. The time frame of these workshops may change due to shifts in the project schedule.
